

# GREATER OREGON SAFARI

**The Safari Shoot** is the biggest shoot of the year for the Cascadian Bowmen. It is a two day tournament shoot composed of 3D targets. In 2008 we had 40 3D targets for Saturday and 20 for Sunday. Our 3D targets are of North American AND exotic animals. We also have Peanut, our life size 3D elephant sponsored by Spot-Hogg. There will be a shooters meeting at 8:15-am both mornings before the shoot starts.

## All NFAA Divisions and styles recognized

**Money and Trophy Shooters** will shoot separately  
\*\*\*money shooters are not eligible for awards.

**Vendors and Club Sponsors** will be there to offer a variety of services and goods, just look for the colorful tents and displays outside the clubhouse.

**Registration** is for either one or both days, but to win an award or trophy, you must shoot both days.

Pre-registration for the shoot must be received by June 30th. Late Registration check in is; Friday evening 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Saturday morning 6:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.

Sunday morning 6:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.

**Registration Fees and Money Shoot Fees** will be posted by March 15 at the latest.

**The shoot will start** each morning (rain or shine) with a 'Shotgun Start'. Shooters will select which target on the range they will start with, then are given 15 minutes to reach their designated target. At the set time, we will ring a very loud gong bell that will signify the shoot has begun. You will start shooting and continue around the course until you reach the target you started with. Once you have completed the course, you must continue around the course to come out safely at the clubhouse, even if this means walking the target course again that you just shot. Turn in completed scores cards each day to the clubhouse.

**The Cascadian Kitchen** will have a special Friday Dinner (menu to be announced), Breakfast and lunch available Saturday & Sunday. There will also be a big dinner on Saturday night. The kitchen will also have water and soft drinks available or you can get a pop from the vending machine.

**Camping is free and dry** in the pines along the Long Tom River. RVs and tents are welcome. There are no reservations for camping, it's first come first served.

## Directions to the Range

### From the South

I-5 exit 195 West (Junction City / Airport)

Travel West on Beltline 6.5 miles to exit 6 (Airport).

Turn Left onto HWY 99.

Turn Left onto Clear Lake Rd.

Stay on Clear Lake Rd, at the stop sign for Territorial HWY, Clear Lake Rd. becomes Lawrence Rd.

Continue straight through the intersection on Lawrence Rd. and turn left on HWY 36.

Turn Left on Poodle Creek Rd.

We are the first driveway on the right.

### From the North

I-5 exit 209.

Travel to Harrisburg and turn Left onto HWY 99

Continue South through Junction City.

South of Junction City, turn Right at HWY 36 (CFN on Corner), and continue on HWY 36 for approximately 13 miles.

Turn Left onto Poodle Creek Rd.

We are the first driveway on the right.
